## \*Construction Industry Progress Fund (CIPF) applies only to State and Municipal Davis Bacon jobs on full commercial carpenter rates only.

If the holiday falls on a Sunday, the Monday following will also be a legal holiday. All work performed on Sunday and Holidays shall be paid at two (2) times the straight time rate of pay. If the holiday falls on a Saturday, then the following shall apply:

Employers/Employees who regularly work a five day work week shall observe the holiday on the previous Friday (the day before the holiday).

Employers/Employees who regularly work a six day or seven day work week shall observe the holiday on the Saturday upon which the holiday falls.

After no more than 360 hours of work a Pre-Apprentice shall be referred to the Apprenticeship for indenture as a 1st Period Apprentice. Pre-Apprentices CANNOT work on prevailing wage project:
